INTERNATIONAL MIXED SCRAMBLE

Thursday, June 19, 2008 – Westview Golf Course, Quincy, Illinois

FORMAT: 9-hole, 4-person (mixed) Scramble in four age divisions (5-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17). Tournament Committee will make foursome pairings; players cannot sign up as a team.

ELIGIBILITY: Any boy or girl who participates in the 2008 Pepsi Little People's June 18-20, and who is between the age of 5 and 17 as of June 18, 2008. Age of player determined by his/her age on June 18, 2008 (same age as used in Little People's).

SPONSORS: Refreshment Services Pepsi and Little People's Golf Championships Association.

RULES OF PLAY: Each team will be made up of four (4) players, pairings at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. No rule as to ratio of males/females per team. Each team member will tee off on each hole; team will select the best ball to be played for next shot. The three team members whose balls were NOT selected to be played shall each play from within six inches (no nearer hole) of selected ball placement. Team will then select the best ball to be played for the next shot. The three team members whose balls were NOT selected to be played shall each play from within six inches (no nearer hole) of selected ball placement. Continue this method throughout each hole. On the green, the three non-selected balls must be played from the spot of the selected shot (NO six inch rule). Each player's drive MUST be used at least twice during the nine holes. If team has only three players, all three may play each selected shot; each player must have a minimum of two tee shots selected, and a maximum of four. USGA Rules must be used throughout.

CADDIES: Each participant, regardless of age, may have one caddie.

TEES: Boys and Girls 5-8 play Gold Tees; Boys and Girls 9-11 play Red Tees; Boys and Girls 12-14 play White Tees; Boys 15-17 play Blue Tees and Girls 15-17 play White Tees.

PRIZES: Trophies will be awarded to the teams finishing 1st and 2nd. In case of a tie, winner will be determined by a sudden-death playoff NOT to exceed two holes. If winner is not determined after two playoff holes, winner will be determined by matching scorecards backwards, starting with the last regulation hole played. In case of inclement weather or time, a tie may be determined by any other method determined by Tournament Committee. Each contestant not receiving a 1st or 2nd place trophy will receive a small trophy or medal.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Monday, June 16, 2008. Refund policy same as Little People's.
