

INFORMATION ON QUALIFYING FOR JUNIOR WORLD at LITTLE PEOPLE'S

To All Parents:

Pepsi Little People's is a qualifier for boys and girls 6 through 14 for the 2010 Callaway Golf Junior World. The lowest scoring boy and girl aged 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 will qualify to play in Junior World July 12-16 IF he or she has registered to try to qualify at Little People's and has met the birthdate qualifications. There is a \$5 qualifying fee which goes to Junior World.

Age groups for Junior World are 6 and under, 7-8, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17. If your child's birthday falls between June 23 and July 15, and he or she will be moving into the next Junior World age division, then he or she is NOT eligible to qualify at Little People's. I know this is confusing, so here is an example:

'If Sarah is entered in Little People's as a 7-year-old and turns 8 before Junior World (July 15), she CAN try to qualify at Little People's as she would be playing in the 7-8 division at Junior World.

'If Robert is entered in Little People's as an 8-year-old, and turns 9 before Junior World (July 15), he can NOT try to qualify at Little People's because he would be moving into the 9-10 division at Junior World.'

In order to be eligible to try to qualify at Little People's, you must meet the above requirements, pay the \$5 qualifying fee, and sign up at Little People's registration before 6 pm on Monday, June 21.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR TRYING TO QUALIFY FOR JUNIOR WORLD

If your child is eligible, and wishes to try to qualify for Junior World at Little People's, you must register at the Registration Table at Westview between 10 am and 6 pm on Sunday, June 20, or between 8 am and 6 pm on Monday, June 21.

There is NO registration for trying to qualify at Little People's previous to 10 am on June 20, and NO registration to try to qualify after 6 pm on Monday, June 21. Qualifying fee is \$5, which goes to Junior World. You may only register to try to qualify at Little People's during regular registration hours at Westview Golf Course.
