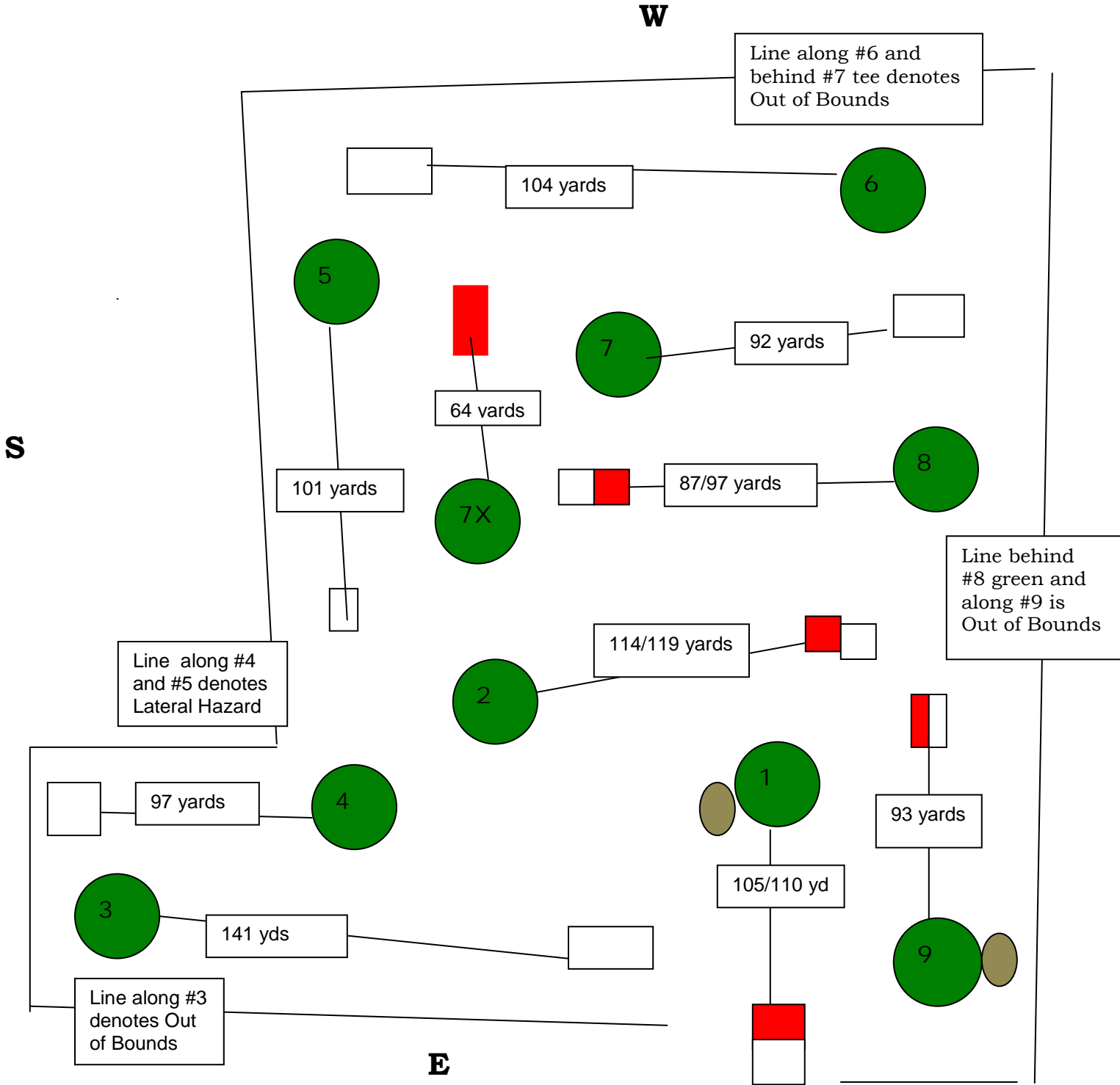


KC PAR-3 AS IT WILL BE PLAYED IN 2016 PEPSI LITTLE PEOPLE'S

(Please note that this map is NOT drawn to scale)

Divisions 1-B and 1-G (ages 3-5) will play 5 holes, holes #1-#2-#7X-#8-#9, from the RED tees (463 yards)

Divisions 2-B and 2-G (ages 6-7) will play 9 holes, holes #1-#9 from the WHITE tees (954 yards)



Special Rules for Divisions 1 and 2:

1 Players may lay out of sand bunkers on #1 and #9, no nearer hole, no penalty. Do not keep the bunker between ball and green. Lay out to the side.

2 Play preferred lies (winter rules) during all rounds. Lie, but NOT POSITION, may be improved any place on the course with hand or clubhead, six inches only, no nearer hole

3 It is highly recommended that parents restrict their time helping the player line up his/her shot, especially for Division 2, and particularly on the greens.

4 Each player is allowed **TWO PRACTICE SWINGS ONLY** on each shot. Repeated offense of this rule could lead to the player being penalized or disqualified.

5 There IS rough at KC Par-3. Lie, but not position, may be improved with hand or clubhead, six inches only, no nearer hole.

6 For 3-5 year olds (Division 1), if a ball lands behind a tree or if tree interferes with swing, there is a free drop, no penalty. There is NO relief from trees for 6-7 year olds (Division 2) except for those trees marked by stakes.

7 For 6-7 year olds (Division 2), if a ball goes into the woods on the left of #4 or #5, play as lateral hazard and drop ball within two club-lengths of where ball crossed marked line, no nearer hole, with one-stroke penalty.

8 There is a limit of 12 strokes per hole, INCLUDING whiffs, for all players in Divisions 1 and 2.

9 There is out-of-bounds to left of #3, #6 and #9, and behind #7 tee and behind # 6 and #8 greens.

10 Caddie may place ball on tee or help player place ball on tee, and may improve lie on fairway; caddie can place player in proper position to swing at the ball and point out line, but may NOT stand on or close to an extension of the line of play or on the line of play behind the ball while player is making his/her stroke. Caddie may not place a mark indicating the line. Penalty two strokes.

11 Each player in Division 1 and 2 may have ONE caddie at a time, who must keep the scorecard. Scorecards must be exchanged within the group, but it is advised that each caddie keep his/her own score also. Compare scores after each hole. Caddie may change during a round, but player may have ONE caddie only at any time. Caddie may carry contestant in Divisions 1 if necessary

12 Please let your player play his/her own game as much as possible.
