SPECIAL AWARDS FOR 2019 TSJGT PLAYERS

OVERALL WINNERS – During the first eight events, or ‘Regular Season’, trophies and points will be given for first place (14 points), medals and points for second (10), third (8), and points only for fourth (6), fifth (4) and participation (2). These will be awarded per Division. The top 50 overall point winners will be invited to play in the **TRI STATE CUP CHAMPIONSHIP** at Spring Lake Country Club August 5! In the final event, point totals will be worth 1.5 times the regular season amount (i.e. 1st, 21 points, 2nd, 15 points, 3rd 12 points, etc.) The TRI STATE CUP winner will be the golfer with the most cumulative season points after the Spring Lake event August 5. Awards for the TRI STATE CUP Champions to be determined.

Participants of the TSJGT will NOT:

- Use abusive language
- Throw clubs for any reason (subject to 1 stroke penalty per offense)
- Abuse or damage the host golf course
- Participate in dishonest play or scoring of any kind
- Use cell phones at any time during tournament play

Spectators and Parents of TSJGT participants will:

- Stay on cart paths, rough, or 30 yards away from participants.
- **Not walk in the fairways**
- Try to stay a shot ahead of the group you are following
- Not give advice or rulings to any participants
- Help spot and search for balls off the fairway
- Approach the greens (10 yards away) to watch players putt
- Turn cell phones to vibrate, sounds off, or the off position

Violation of any of these policies could result in penalty/disqualification.
