RULES FOR VIRTUAL 2020 PEPSI LITTLE PEOPLE'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS

1 - Player will play a course of his/her choosing from the tees you normally play at this course. Please indicate on entry form above the color tees you played so that we can calculate your score.

For players ages 3 through 9, play the approximate yardage shown below.

Boys 8-9 – Approximate yardage 2459 yards for 9 holes

Girls 8-9 – Approximate yardage 1768 for 9 holes

Boys and Girls 6-7 – Approximate yardage 954 yards for 9 holes

Boys and Girls 3-5 – Approximate yardage 463 yards for 5 holes

2 – Play must be between the dates of Thursday, June 18, and Wednesday, June 24

3 –All players in the Virtual Little People's must play two rounds between June 18 and June 24. A picture of the scorecards, showing hole by hole scores, and signatures of player and player attesting score, must be emailed to Little People's headquarters, jrgolfer@littlepeoplesgolf.com, or may be mailed to 1600 Wapiti Circle Unit 8, Estes Park, CO 80517, to be received by Saturday, June 27. Be sure player's name is visible on the scorecards. Please circle the tees that you played. All players and playing partners are on their honor to uphold the Rules of Golf.

4 – Player must play with one other person, friend, fellow Little People's competitor, parent, sibling or other relative. This person must attest to the validity of the score. Playing partner need not be the same for both rounds.

5 – Players must adhere to the current USGA Rules of Golf as designated at the course you play. All players are on their honor to uphold the Rules of Golf.

6 – Players ages 12-18 must walk and carry their own clubs or use a pull cart, and cannot receive advice from anyone, including their playing partner.

7 – Players 10-11 must walk but may have a caddy, and can receive advice from said caddy.

8 -- Players 3-9 may have a caddy and must walk. Caddy may give advice. Caddy may carry players ages 3-5 if necessary for them to complete their round.

9 – No golf cars are allowed in any age division -- no player may ride in a golf car.

10 – Little People's welcomes all pictures and videos of players as they play in this unique virtual golf tournaments, to be used on the Little People's social media and for future events.

11 – Remember – this is a 'virtual' golf tournament, designed to give our players a chance at some competition during these trying times, and have fun playing and competing against others their age.

12 – Thank you for being a part of this unique, pioneering golf tournament! All of us at Little People's appreciate your competitive spirit, and look forward to seeing you in Quincy, June 21-23, 2021.
