



APPLEBEE'S PARENT-CHILD RULES AND TEES

Information on Prizes and Rules for Putting Contest, Driving Contest, and Best Dressed Teams

Sunday, June 19, 2022, Westview Golf Course, Quincy, Illinois

FORMAT – **Child** will tee off on **odd** numbered holes (19-21-23-25-27); **partner** will tee off on **even** numbered holes (20-22-24-26). Players must alternate shots until ball is holed. Whiffs count as a shot (i.e. if parent whiffs, the child plays the next shot).

TEEING AREAS –

Boy and Girls ages 3-7 play from the **ORANGE** tees

Boys and Girls ages 8-13 play from the **YELLOW** tees

Boys and Girls ages 14-18 play from the **WHITE** tees

All adult females aged 22 and over, and males aged 62 and over, play from the **RED** tees

All adult males aged 22 through 61, play from the **WHITE** tees

TEAM DIVISIONS – Divisions based on child's age and gender.

Three Divisions for Boys; three Divisions for Girls... (3-7, 8-13, 14-18)

There is an Alumni-Child Division – please indicate if you wish to compete in this Division also at time of registration (no extra charge).

PRIZES – Three (3) places awarded in each Division. Trophies will be presented at Family Celebration Picnic at KC on Monday night

RULES – Ties will be determined by scorecard playoff beginning with last hole and going backwards.

Players **must** alternate shots throughout hole. A whiff counts as a stroke.

USGA Rules, but ball may be played up

APPLEBEE'S PUTTING CONTEST: On the practice green at Westview from 11 to 4 pm Sunday for all teams, at NO additional charge. Each person plays own ball and scores of partner and child **will be combined**. Medals will be given to 1st and 2nd places in each division. Boys and girls will combine for three age divisions (3-7, 8-13, 14-18).

APPLEBEE'S DRIVING CONTEST: All juniors playing in the Parent-Child event must tee off from his/her appointed tee on #19. Tee shot will count for Driving Contest AND for first shot for team. NO additional charge. One drive per player only. Drives must be in the fairway to be counted for Driving Contest, but may be in rough for Parent-Child event. Medals will be given to 1st and 2nd places in each division (Boys 3-7, 8-13, 14-18, and Girls 3-7, 8-13, 14-18).

APPLEBEE'S BEST DRESSED TEAMS – Prizes will be given to the 1st and 2nd Best Dressed Teams, (NOT COSTUMES) and others as deemed fit, playing in the 2022 Applebee's Parent-Child Event.
